From the West: Take Pennsylvania Turnpike I-76 E (Portions Toll) to the Valley Forge Interchange at Exit 326. Merge onto Schuylkill expressway I-76 E towards Philadelphia after you pay the toll. Take the exit # 330 towards Gulph Mills. At the end of the ramp turn right onto S. Gulph Road/PA 320. Continue straight on S. Gulph Road till it becomes Montgomery Avenue. Continue for about 3-4 miles. Pass Shipley and Baldwin Schools on your left, pass Harcum College on your right. After the Pennswood Road intersection, at the 2nd light turn right onto Haverford Station Road. Next light turn left onto Lancaster Avenue. Turn right onto the main entrance of the Haverford campus (just past the “Haverford College” sign) onto College Lane. See **Residential Students** or **Day Students** below.

From north of Philadelphia: Take I-476 South (NE Extension of the PA Turnpike). Pay toll at Mid County Interchange. Follow I-476 South to Interchange #13 (US 30) St. Davids/Villanova. Turn east on Lancaster Avenue (US 30 East). Proceed east on Lancaster Avenue for about 3.5 miles through Villanova, Rosemont and Bryn Mawr to Haverford. After you pass the Haverford Post Office on your left, turn right at the main entrance of the Haverford campus (just past the “Haverford College” sign) onto College Lane. See **Residential Students** or **Day Students** below.

From northern New Jersey/New York: Take NJ Turnpike South. Leave the New Jersey Turnpike at Exit 6 (Pennsylvania Turnpike entrance). Join the Pennsylvania Turnpike, driving west to the exit for I-476 (Mid County Exit). Pay toll. Take I-476 South/Chester. Proceed south on I-476 to Interchange #13 (US 30) St. Davids/Villanova. Turn east on Lancaster Avenue (US 30 E). Proceed east on Lancaster Avenue for about 3.5 miles through Villanova, Rosemont and Bryn Mawr to Haverford. After you pass the Haverford Post Office on your left, turn right at the main entrance of the Haverford campus (just past the “Haverford College” sign) onto College Lane. See **Residential Students** or **Day Students** below.

From southern New Jersey: Take New Jersey Turnpike to 322 West. Cross the Commodore Barry Bridge to I-95 North; follow I-95 North to Exit #7 for I-476. Follow I-476 north to Interchange #13 (US 30) St. Davids/Villanova. Turn east on Lancaster Avenue (US 30). Proceed east on Lancaster Avenue for about 3.5 miles through Villanova, Rosemont and Bryn Mawr to Haverford. After you pass the Haverford Post Office on your left, turn right at the main entrance of the Haverford campus (just past the “Haverford College” sign) onto College Lane. See **Residential Students** or **Day Students** below.

From Center City By Car: Join I-76 West (Schuylkill Expressway) and drive west following Valley forge signs. Take exit marked City Avenue (US 1 South). As soon as you see the City Avenue exit sign, get into the extreme left lane. Once on City Avenue, travel about 2 1/2 miles, turn right on to Lancaster Avenue (US 30 West) and drive about 3 miles through Wynnewood and Ardmore to Haverford. The “Haverford College” sign and College Lane are on the left. Enter the College at College Lane. See **Residential Students** or **Day Students** below. Estimated driving time: 30 minutes.

From Center City By Train: Go to Penn Center Station (also called Suburban Station) at 16th and J.F. Kennedy Blvd., or to 30th Street Station (Amtrak) at 30th and Market Streets. Take either the R5 Paoli Local or the Bryn Mawr Local to Haverford (not all trains stop at Haverford). Estimated train time to Haverford station: 16 minutes from 30th Street; 19 minutes from Suburban Station. The walk from Haverford station to the campus is 8 to 10 minutes (down Haverford Station Road, across Lancaster Avenue, right on to Railroad Avenue, left onto campus at Carter Road). See **Residential Students** or **Day Students** below.

From Philadelphia International Airport By Car: Leaving the airport, take I-95 South to exit #7 for I-476. Proceed north on I-476 to Interchange #13 (US 30) St. Davids/Villanova. Turn east on Lancaster Avenue (US 30 E). Proceed east on Lancaster Avenue for about 3.5 miles through Villanova, Rosemont and Bryn Mawr to Haverford. After you pass the Haverford Post Office on your left, turn right at the main entrance of the Haverford campus (just past the “Haverford College” sign) onto College Lane. See **Residential Students** or **Day Students** below.

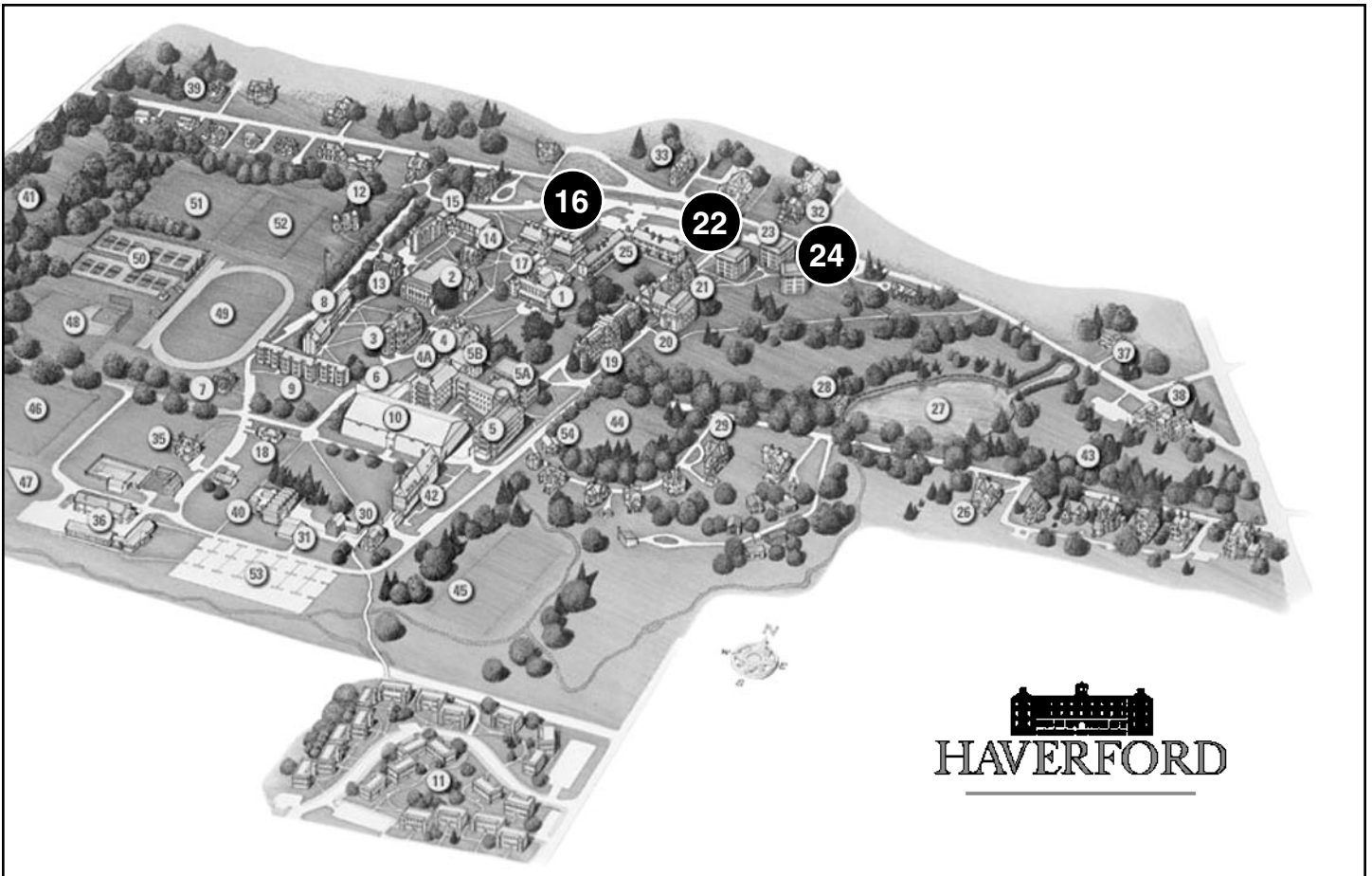
From Washington D.C. and Other Points South Via I-95: Take I-95 N. After Chester take exit #7 for I-476. Follow I-476 North/Plymouth Meeting. Continue to interchange #13 (US 30) St. Davids/Villanova. Turn east on Lancaster Avenue (US 30 East). Proceed east on Lancaster Avenue for about 3.5 miles through Villanova, Rosemont and Bryn Mawr to Haverford. After you pass the Haverford Post Office on your left, turn right at the main entrance of the Haverford campus (just past the “Haverford College” sign) onto College Lane. See **Residential Students** or **Day Students** below.

From Washington D.C. and Other Points South Via Rt. 1: Stay on US 1 (making sure to take the Media By-Pass) to I-476 North/Plymouth Meeting. Continue on I-476 to Interchange #13 (US 30) St. Davids/Villanova. Turn east on Lancaster Avenue (US 30 East). Proceed east on Lancaster Avenue for about 3.5 miles through Villanova, Rosemont and Bryn Mawr to Haverford. After you pass the Haverford Post Office on your left, turn right at the main entrance of the Haverford campus (just past the “Haverford College” sign) onto College Lane. See **Residential Students** or **Day Students** below.

Residential Students — follow signs to Comfort Hall (#24 on the map, off Carter Road).

Day Students — follow signs to Dining Center, (#16 on map, off Carter Road)
