Students entering grades 11, 12, or freshmen year in college. Ideal candidates are students who can display an eagerness and willingness to experience the working world first-hand in a field of their choice that interests them.

Deadlines:

Applications are reviewed on a rolling basis in waves. Internship opportunities do fill up, so it is highly recommended to apply early to secure your placement!

Supplemental Materials You Need to Apply:

The following are supplemental pieces to the application to be emailed, faxed, uploaded or mailed:

1.	Letter of Recommendation	We will e-mail the recommender directly to offer our letter of recommendation form. The student should follow up with the recommender to ensure the e-mail was received.
2.	Optional Personal Letter of Recommendation	A personal letter of recommendation should appear on letterhead and sent to JKCP.
3.	Copy of High School Transcript with Fall 2011 Grades	If you do not have your fall grades yet, please send the transcript with a recent report card and or progress report.
4.	Passport-style Photo	Please make sure the color photo was taken within the past 6 months , that you are facing forward , that the background is plain and white, off-white or light in color , and remember that hats are not permitted . Photo should be saved as a .jpeg image and e-mailed as an attachment to upload.IN_Phot.c2t0g695ah@u.box.net
5.	Résumé	Résumé must include any applicable information below, in this specific order: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Extracurricular activities (e.g. sports, arts, community service, after school classes, school newspaper, etc...) 2. Any academic, community or athletic honors or awards 3. Work and/or volunteer experience <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Name of Company or Non-Profit • Supervisor's Name • Length of Job • Description of responsibilities

When Your Application is Complete:

Once your application is complete (with online application and supplemental materials received), we will contact you to schedule a professional phone interview during the specified dates below. This interview generally lasts from 20-30 minutes. An additional phone interview between the student and the mentor may be required for certain internships.
